Directions to Heber Springs Community Center

FROM LITTLE ROCK:

- Take exit 16B to merge onto AR-5 N toward Heber Springs.
- Turn right on AR-36 E.
- Turn left onto AR-5 N.
- Keep right to continue on AR-16E/AR-25N/AR-5N Heber Springs Rd.
- Slight left onto AR-25N/AR-5N Heber Springs Rd.
- Turn left onto AR-25Bypass N/ Heber Springs Rd
- Continue to follow AR-25 Bypass N.
- Turn right onto Heber Springs Rd/ W Main St.
- Turn left onto AR-25 Bypass N/ N 2nd St.
- Continue to follow AR-25 Bypass N.
- Turn right onto Bobbie Jean Lane Community.

- Center will be on the right.

FROM BATESVILLE:

- Continue to follow AR-25 S/Heber Springs Rd.
- Turn right onto AR-25 Bypass S/ Heber Springs Rd N.
- Turn left onto Tulaka Blvd.
- Take the 1st right onto Bobbie Jean Lane Community.
- Center will be on the right.

Please note: If using a GPS, put in 2111 Hwy 25B. The center's address is not on a GPS, but it is located beside Good Times Restaurant.
